 Manzanita status: declined single bid; water line shutoff installation scheduled for summer, Kindergarten playground complete

- Playgrounds: Scheduled to complete 5 playgrounds this summer; work has been completed on Manzanita and Bonny View's Elementary playground
- Sequoia Snack Bar: the project is scheduled to begin June 17 with completion happening before the start of the school year
