  - Rob reviewed Student Data for all three District's which included Basic Phonics Kills Test (BPST, State Testing Results, Suspension and Absenteeism
- ii. Literacy Presentation by Cindy Bishop Literacy/Reading/New Teachers
  - Reading Wars RSD uses Structured Literacy where readers use phonics knowledge first to decode unknown words, then uses context to confirm. The use of explicit, sequential, systematic, prescriptive, diagnostic, cumulative, and assessment-driven
  - RSD Culture of Reading California Reading & Literature Project (CRLP), CORE Reading Institute, SIPPS Training/coaching, new teachers get 35 hours with teacher mentor and all K – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classrooms use decodable text and have a classroom library of books
